

ECONOMIC IMPACT

As the largest employer in South Dakota, Sanford's economic activity supported more than **26,172 jobs** for South Dakotans, representing more than **\$1.7 billion** in wages.

Our combined economic impact added **\$2.3 billion** to South Dakota's GDP and contributed **\$4.5 billion** to the economy.

Sanford's construction produced an average of more than **600 jobs** and **\$37.2 million** in wages annually over the past four years. These projects contributed an average of **\$88.1 million** to the economy each year.

This study was conducted utilizing IMPLAN, a nationally recognized economic impact modeling system based on 2019 data to calculate the 2020 impact from Sanford operations in North Dakota, South Dakota, Minnesota and Iowa. The methodology estimates economic relationships between industries, households and government.
