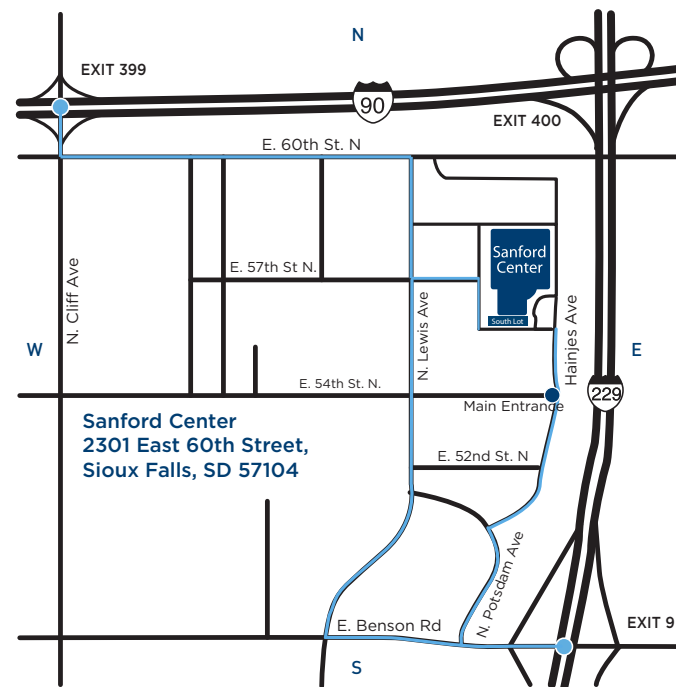
Parking is available in the event lot located on the west side of the Sanford Center, as shown on the map. Please do not park in the front of the building (south side).

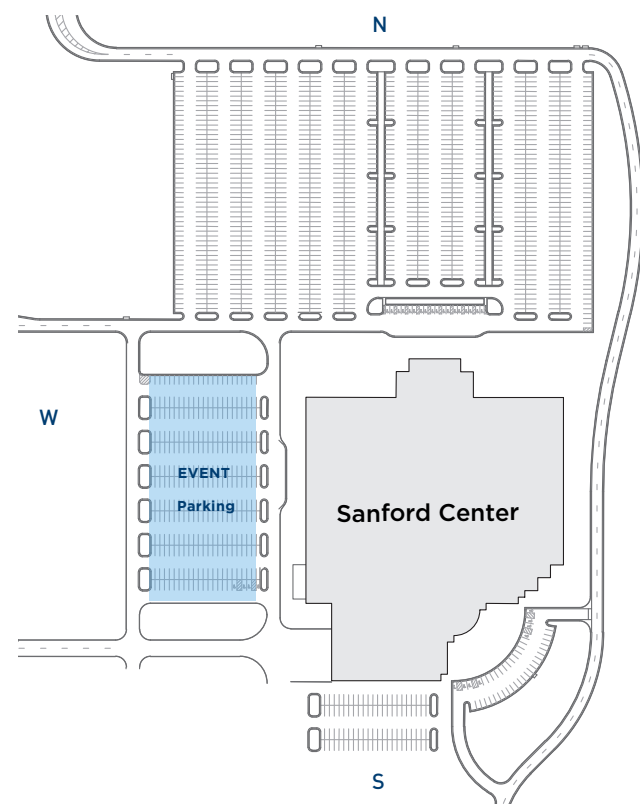
